Programming Menu:

Visiting Artist/Demonstration - Perfect for limited time, budget, and space. Also great for a large audience and very young children. Includes demonstration of working on the potter's wheel, examples of finished work, and a clay lecture.

Workshop - Perfect for a classroom program. This is an in class, hands-on project coordinated with the teacher and based on a lesson plan. Would meet one or two times.

Extended Study Workshop - Ideal for long term programming such as after school programs, senior centers, occupational therapy programs, camps, etc. where the same group of students work for an extended period of time over several weeks. Minimum of three visits. This is also a hands-on project coordinated with the teacher or director.

Community or School Large Scale Project - The Claymobile will design or assist in the design and creation of large scale projects such as clay murals, mosaics, and sculpture within the community or school setting. This is a great idea for long lasting class gifts from the students to their schools and a great beautification project for neighborhood organizations. Fee based on project.

Teacher Professional Development Workshops - Programming available for helping to integrate clay into the classroom and the curriculum. Workshops also available for a wide variety of technical issues such as how to fire an electric kiln, glaze chemistry, mixing and testing glazes, working with slips, etc. Fees vary based on programming.

Boy Scout/ Girl Scout Badge Certification Program - Includes a demonstration, a tour of the studio, and a hands on handbuilding project. Minimum of 10 troop members. One visit (1-1.5hours).

Corporate Teambuilding - Great idea to build a sense of "team" within your organization. Programming and fees vary.
